- a) Seal coating will be done with 340\* 5% cutback ac blend asphalt and a fractured washed stone or a black slag.
  - b) A fractured washed stone and black slag aggregates.
  - c) Both asphalt and aggregate will be applied full width in one pass
  - d) Road surface will be cleaned and cold mix hand patched prior to seal coating.
  - e) Pug mill cold mix will be used for paver patching.
  - f) The finished seal coat will be rolled with a duo-packer roller.
- g) Certificate of Insurance must be included. Payment and Performance bonds may be required.
  - h) A list of three (3) references where like work has been done is required.
  - i) Prices will be given for each project with a total price for all projects.
- 5) The road list is as follows:
- a) Oak Road south of Zoar Road-approximately .62 mile by 22 feet-hot oil seal coat with approximately 15% double seal
- b) Oak Road north of Olden Road-approximately 650 feet by 20 feet-double hot oil seal coat
- c) Center road from Hill Road east-approximately 900 feet by 22 feet-hot oil seal coat
- d) Fremont Road from Highway 26 east-approximately 825 feet by 20 feet-double hot oil seal coat and approximately 2400 feet by 20 feet single hot oil seal coat
- e) Hickory Road from Highway 26 to Getzel Road-.49 mile by 23 feet-hot oil seal coat

f) Triangle Road south of Zoar Road-approximately 850 feet by 22 feet-hot oil seal coat
